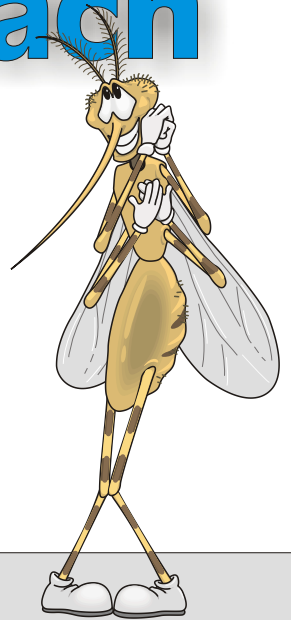

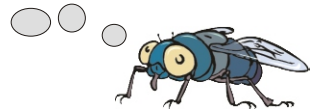

What Can We Offer You?

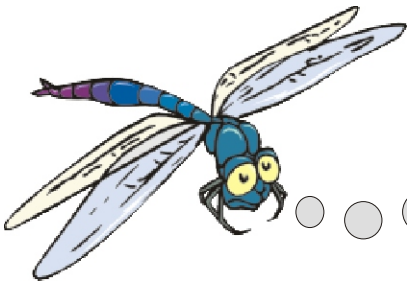


Insect Program Student Workbooks (4th - 6th grades)

Our 20 page workbook is filled with fun activities that teach biological concepts. These workbooks follow the California Science Framework guidelines and incorporate geography, history, literature, and writing into the study of insects! The class set includes: workbooks, a teacher's edition, bookmarks, color pages, and a pest police board game. Order for your class or the entire grade level!

Classroom Presentations (all grades)

Basic presentations cover insect characteristics and life cycles. We teach the role mosquitoes play in nature, the importance of mosquito control and vector-borne disease prevention, as well as safety around bees and other wild animals. We also offer a "Careers in Public Health" presentation for middle and high school age students. Materials can include: a PowerPoint show, pinned insect collections, hands on visuals, literature for kids, parents and teachers, and even some live "critters"! Loan boxes provide flexibility and a wide range of activities for many different reading and learning levels. You can teach the basics or expand into insect anatomy, classification, even predator/prey relationships (upon request).
